Conditions list

A patient can receive **free treatments via the scheme** (if they are eligible for free prescriptions) for the conditions listed below.

Allergies Earache Eczema Scabies Vaginal Thrush Head lice

A consultation fee can be claimed for any of the conditions listed below, where the pharmacy team has given advice, guidance and support to a patient. Where a consultation for one of the above symptoms has been carried out and a product is required, the patient should be asked to pay for a product. If a patient is unable to purchase a medicine, pharmacy teams can make a supply via the scheme.

Note - The decision to make a supply is at the Pharmacy teams' discretion and should be made on a case-by-case basis.
