

Briefing Note for the Sub-Contracting of Pharmacy Provision for Enhanced Contraception 2022/23

The Rotherham NHS Foundation Trust (TRFT) has been commissioned by Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council Public Health (RMBC) to provide community pharmacy provision of an emergency oral contraceptive from 1st April 2022 onwards.

As Pharmacies had previously been commissioned directly by RMBC, we have continued to offer a sub-contract service to all Pharmacies in the Rotherham Borough to maintain access for service users across Rotherham for the consultation and issue of EHC.

Governance

Each Practitioner will be required to operate under the PGD issued by TRFT and records will be audited accordingly.

<u>Training</u>

The relevant CPPE modules and an on-line training package (As stipulated in the service specification) must be completed for accreditation.

Remuneration

All claims must be entered on PharmOutcomes for payment. Providers will be required to submit their claims by no later than the 5th working day of the following month and payment will be made on a monthly basis. Please be aware that bank holidays are not working days therefore please make your adjustments for claims accordingly.

The PharmOutcomes report will generate the amount of monies that will be paid to Pharmacists for the EHC provision and consultations they have carried out within that month.

Contract Arrangements

Pharmacists wishing to continue in this scheme or are participating for the first time will be required to **notify TRFT by no later than 21 March 2022** – email to <u>stacey.smith33@nhs.net</u> to ensure formal contract documentation is issued timely.

Agreed contracts will be issued by no later than 28 March 2022 for commencement on 1 April 2022 for a one-year period.
