

Monitored dosage system

- The patient is a regular MDS user and there have been changes to their medication

Clinical criteria

- 1a. There have been three or more medication changes/additions to medicines on repeat
- 1b. There has been one or more newly started, or changes to, high risk or problematic medicines
- 2. The patient or carers has expressed confusion/ concern over medication on discharge
- 3. The patient has had multiple admissions during a significant period of time or have had a long inpatient stay
- 4. There has been an AKI (Acute Kidney Injury) on admission or during inpatient stay leading to one or more medication change(s)
- 5. The patient was admitted due to a drug – drug/drug disease interaction
- 6. Any other circumstances where the referring pharmacy professional has concerns about medication safety or effectiveness that could be addressed by the DMS
