

Make sure that you collect enough Injecting equipment for yourself & any other people who inject who you might encounter

Try to **wash your hands** prior to opening Injecting equipment

Use sterile water – water from a kettle that is boiled then left to cool is sterile

Try to **return used equipment** for safe disposal.

Never share or reuse injecting equipment

Be Overdose aware – your risk is increased if using heroin on top of prescribed opioid medication or alongside alcohol or Benzodiazepines like Diazepam or Xanax
