When you request an appointment at your GP practice, if you can be treated by a pharmacist, the GP or receptionist will support you to make an appointment at your local community pharmacy rather than at the GP practice.

(adults and children aged 5 years and over)
- ✓ • **Earache**
(children and young adults aged 1 year to 17 years)
- ✓ • **Infected insect bites**
(adults and children aged 1 year and over)
- ✓ • **Impetigo**
(adults and children aged 1 year and over)
- ✓ • **Shingles**
(adults aged 18 and over)
- ✓ • **Urinary tract infection (UTI)**
(women, aged 16 to 64 years)
